Therefore, temperature checks, masks, and social distancing will continue to be part of our worship protocol. Additionally, there will be:

- No in-person auxiliary meetings
- No food services in Fellowship Hall
- No in-person Sunday School or Wednesday Night Service

Preparing for Arrival and Departure

- 1. Doors will open at 9:00 a.m. for our 10:00 a.m. morning worship service.
- 2. Wear an approved face mask at all times while on the church campus. If you do not have a mask, one will be provided to you.
- 3. Follow the direction of our Ushers Ministry for designated seating to adhere to social distancing; Following the benediction, the Ushers Ministry will provide direction as needed on exiting the sanctuary.

Note: During entry and dismissal, members and friends are required to adhere to social distancing protocol and discouraged from unnecessary movement once you are seated.
