

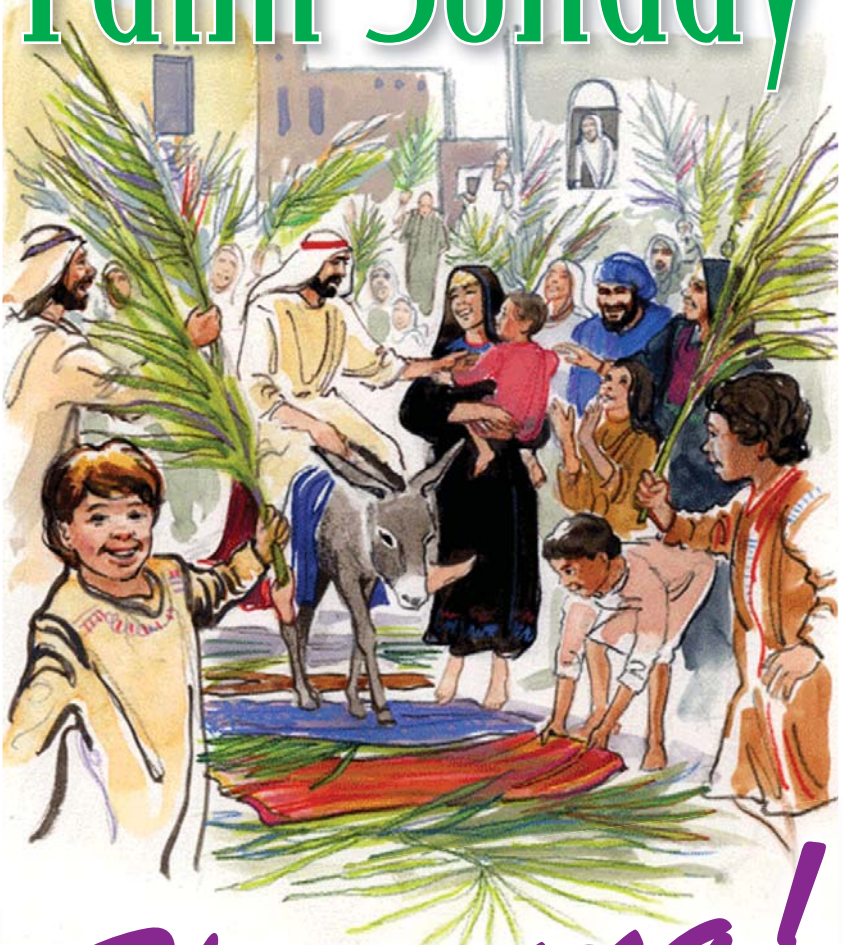

HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY

For the week ending April 5, 2014, 336 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$8,194 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 7,673 pounds of food was distributed, and 483 meals served to AUMI residents.
