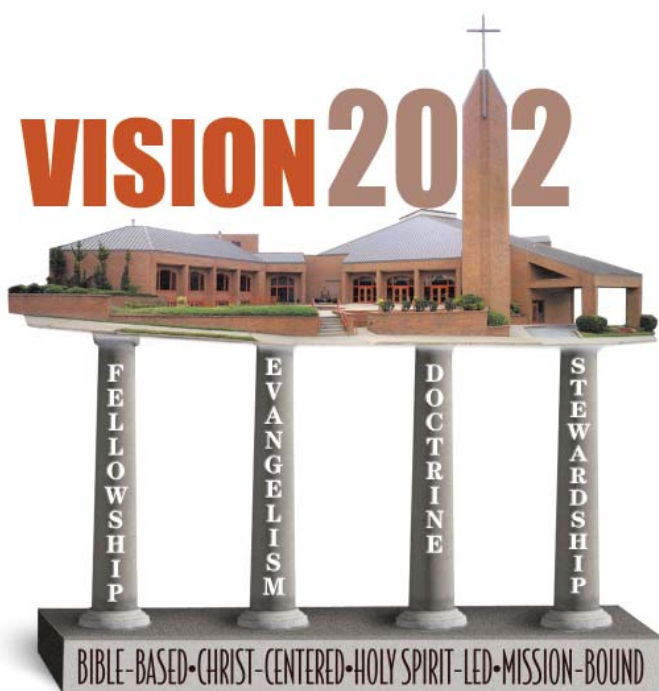

HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY

For the week ending May 26, 2012, 439 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$10,575 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 6,504 pounds of food was distributed, 644 meals served to AUMI residents, and 363 community meals served.
