**GED CLASSES**

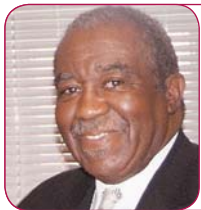
GED classes are held at the AUMI Building every Saturday, 8am-12 noon. Please contact Mr. Bill Hobbs, 404-502-9331 if interested.

### **HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY**

For the week ending May 28, 2011, 292 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$7,140 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 9,794 pounds of food was distributed, 696 meals served to AUMI residents, and 606 community meals served. Eighty (80) boxes distributed to seniors in the CSFP Program for the month of April.
