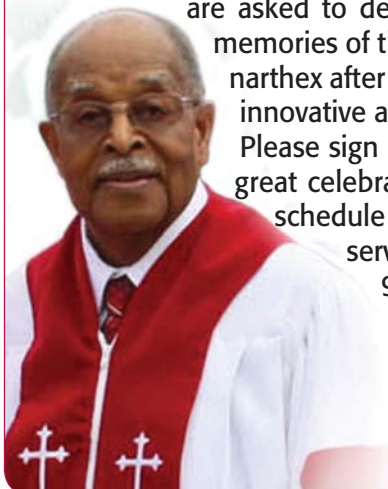


ATTENTION MEMBERS!
