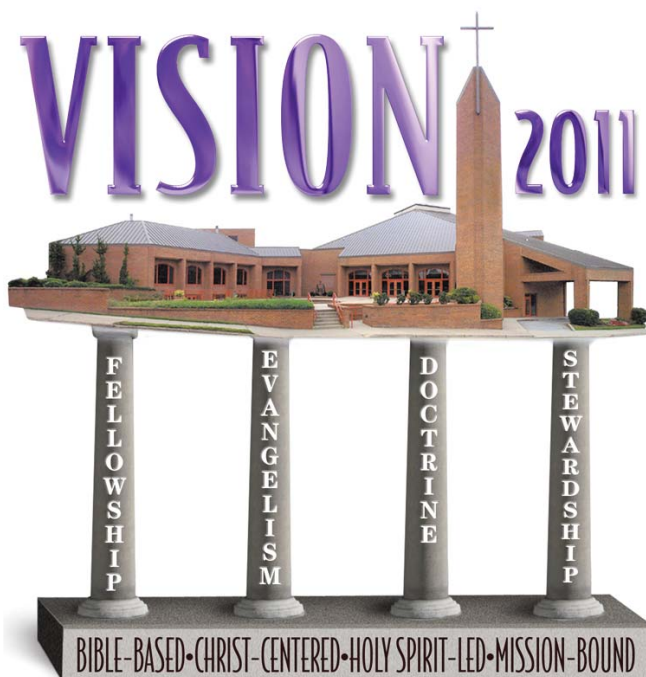

### **HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY**

For the week ending July 23, 2011, 385 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$9,050 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 8,030 pounds of food was distributed, 745 meals served to AUMI residents, and 236 community meals served.
