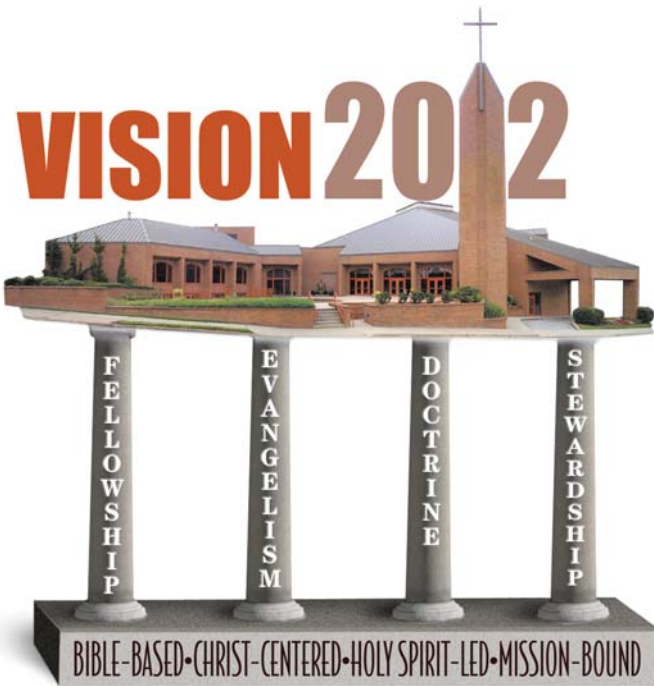

BACK TO SCHOOL FESTIVAL - Saturday, August 25, 10am

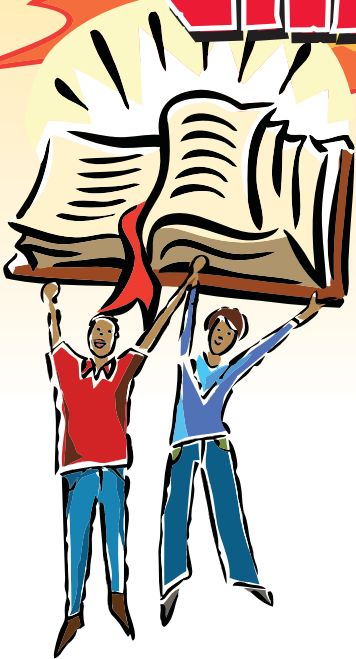

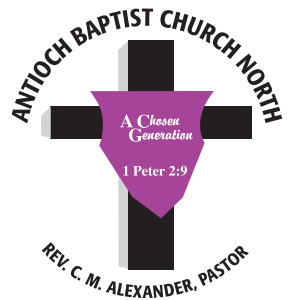
