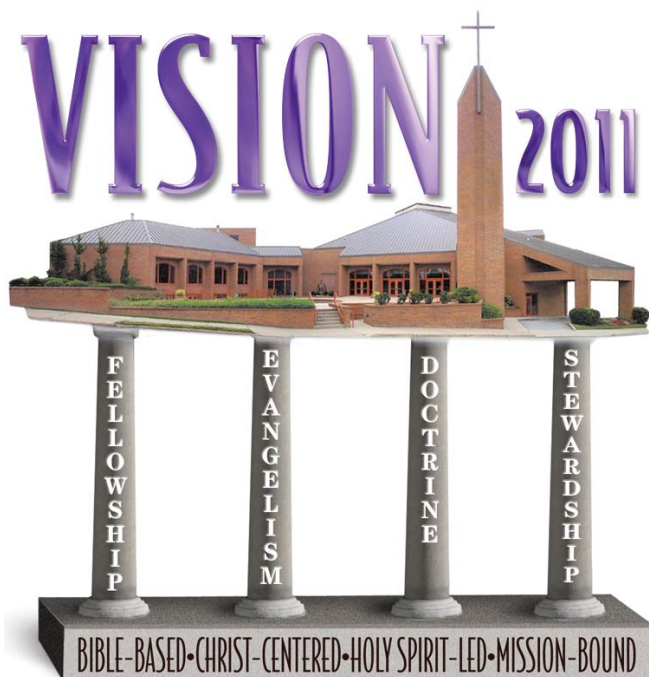

HUMAN SERVICES MINISTRY

For the week ending August 20, 2011, 359 food boxes were distributed. The value of the groceries was \$8,695 (average cost per family estimated at \$48/box if purchased retail). A total of 9,192 pounds of food was distributed, 772 meals served to AUMI residents, and 254 community meals served.
