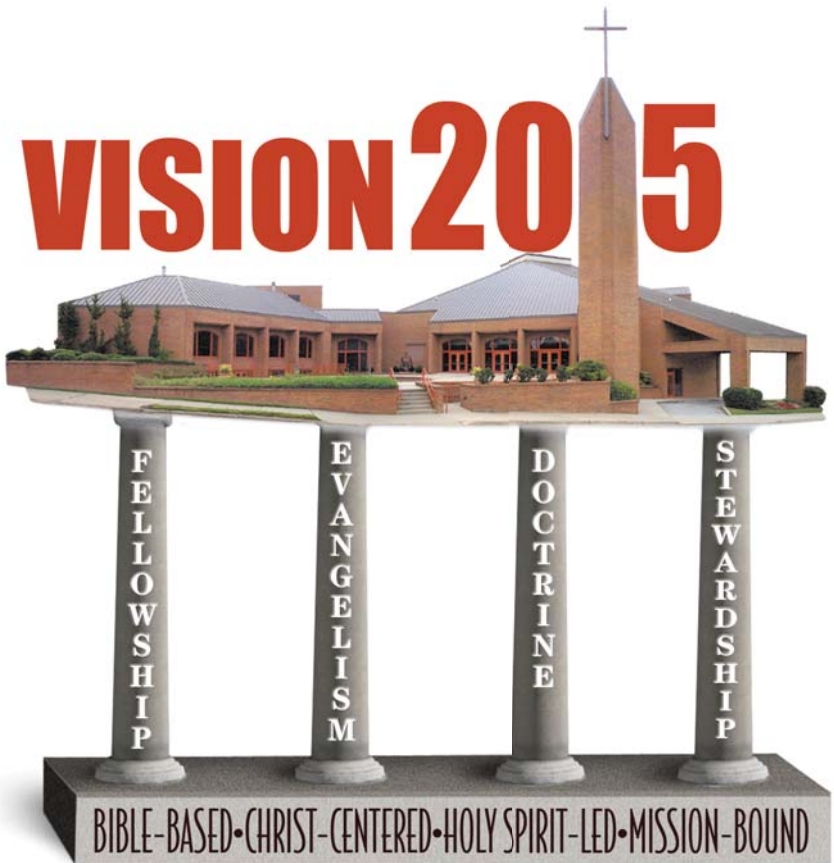

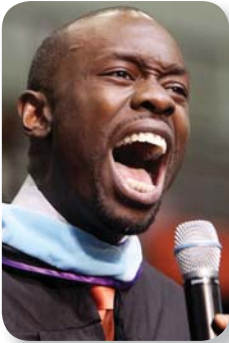
WISE DANCERS
