

A SALUTE TO ANTIOCH PIONEERS

As the Antioch North Family prepares to celebrate its 140th Church Anniversary, we pause today to express our admiration for an elite group of esteemed individuals—our Pioneers. These individuals have stood as stalwart guardians of our beloved Antioch North over the course of 30 or more years of continuous service.

Our Pioneers are Colossians 1:23 Christians who have continued "in the faith firmly established and steadfast, and not moved away from the hope of the gospel that [they] have heard, which was proclaimed in all creation under heaven." Their belief in the Lord Jesus Christ and adherence to the gospel has encouraged them to remain steadfast. They have given of themselves sacrificially using their time, their talents, and their treasures to shore up the biblical foundation upon which Antioch North was built and in which she remains rooted and grounded.

For 30 or more years, the Antioch North Pioneers have put into action the eternal Word of God delivered by her pastors, including our "newsboy" since 1969, the Rev. Dr. Cameron M. Alexander. They have lifted the name of Jesus by working selflessly and sharing freely. 
